HILE Odyssey 2.5 – A Humanistic & Investigative Learning Journey with Pearson Certification

1. Tuition Fees

The HILE Odyssey 2.5 programme has been designed to provide a high-quality, student-centred learning experience that integrates humanistic pedagogy, investigative learning, and internationally recognised Pearson examinations.

Annual Tuition Fee:

€12,700 per academic year

Total Programme Fee (2.5 years):

€31,750

The tuition fee includes:

- Full access to all learning modules and blended learning sessions
- Three intensive summer schools (3 weeks each)
- Pearson certification preparation
- Academic mentoring and personalised learning support
- Learning platforms, digital tools, and assessment systems
- Project-based learning resources, workshops, and guest lectures
- Access to laboratories, studios, and specialised learning spaces
- Student well-being and guidance support
- Boarding and residential facilities during summer schools (if applicable)

2. Additional Costs

The following are **included** in the tuition fee:

- Pearson exam fees (3 subjects × €450 = €1,350)
- Classroom and laboratory materials
- Digital platform licenses
- Administrative and academic services

There are **no additional mandatory charges** unless families request optional services such as extra tutoring, exam resits, or international study trips.

3. Scholarship Opportunities

HILE Odyssey 2.5 is committed to providing access to a broad and diverse group of students. To support this mission, the school offers **need-based and merit-based scholarships** covering between **10% and 30%** of the tuition fee.

3.1 Need-Based Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded to students whose families can demonstrate financial need.

They are designed to ensure that economic circumstances do not prevent talented and motivated students from joining the programme.

Award levels: **10%, 20%, or 30% tuition reduction**

Assessment is based on:

- Household income
- Family circumstances
- Supporting documentation
- Motivation statement from student and/or guardian

3.2 Merit-Based Scholarships

These scholarships recognise outstanding academic achievement, creativity, leadership, or commitment to community engagement.

Criteria may include:

- Strong academic record
- Portfolio of creative or investigative work
- Leadership activities or community contributions
- Interview performance
- Teacher recommendations

Award levels: **10%, 20%, or 30% tuition reduction**

4. Scholarship Conditions

All scholarships:

- Are awarded for one academic year and reviewed annually
- Require students to maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Require positive participation within the HILE learning community
- May be adjusted if family circumstances change significantly

Students receiving a scholarship remain fully eligible for all programme components, including summer schools and Pearson examination sessions.

How to Apply

Applicants must submit:

1. A completed Scholarship Application Form
2. A motivation letter (400–600 words)
3. Most recent academic transcripts
4. Financial documentation (for need-based scholarships)

Scholarship results are provided together with the admission decision.

5. Payment Schedule

Families may choose between one of the following payment options:

Option A – Annual Payment

- Full tuition fee due before the start of each academic year

Option B – Semester Payments

- Two payments per year (June and January)

Option C – Monthly Payment Plan

- 10 instalments from August to May
- Small administrative fee may apply

6. Refund Policy

- The registration fee (if applicable) is non-refundable
- Tuition refunds are possible only in special cases such as relocation or documented medical reasons
- Summer school fees are non-refundable after programme commencement

7. Visa Information for Non-EU / Non-EEA Students

Students from outside the EU/EEA must obtain a **long-stay student visa** to study in Belgium.

Important: Students Must Apply for Their Visa Independently

The applicant is responsible for submitting their visa application at the Belgian Embassy or Consulate in their home country.

What the School Provides

HILE Odyssey supplies all **official documents** required for the student's visa application, including:

- Confirmation of Enrolment
- Official admission letter for Visa Application
- Scholarship Decision Letters
- Confirmation of tuition payment
- Program description and duration
- Statement of accommodation (if applicable)
- Academic Progress Reports
- Certificates of Attendance
- Any additional documentation requested by Belgian authorities

Documents are issued within **5–10 working days**.

Visa-related documents are prioritized during peak periods.

What the Applicant Must Do

- Book an appointment at the nearest Belgian Embassy/Consulate
- Submit all required documents
- Pay visa application fees
- Provide proof of sufficient financial means (Belgium requirement)
- Provide health insurance documentation
- Attend any required interviews

The school will support students administratively but **cannot influence embassy decisions**.

8. Processing Times

Visa processing times vary by country. Students are strongly advised to submit their visa application **at least 3 months before the program start date**.

9. Data Protection & Privacy

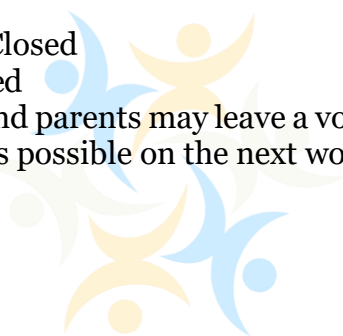
